DAY 1: Zanzibar to Kogatande Airstrip

You'll set out for thrilling game drives across the Kogatende and Bologonja areas, focusing on the remarkable great migration. The herds have gathered along the Mara River, preparing for the legendary river crossing. As they sweep through the Gardenia Valley, Nyamalumbwa Plains, and Sand River, you'll witness one of nature's grandest spectacles — a mass movement of over two million wildebeest, zebras, and gazelles across the Serengeti and Masai Mara in search of greener pastures.

DAY 2: Northern Serengeti National Park

After an early breakfast, you'll enjoy a captivating game drive in the Northern Serengeti, a secluded and untouched part of the park nestled between the Central Serengeti and Kenya's Masai Mara. This remote region offers fewer crowds and stunning landscapes. Here, you'll witness the world's largest mammal migration as massive herds of wildebeest continue their epic 800-kilometer journey. Drawn by the lush grasses of the plains during the rainy season, this area becomes a haven for calving due to clear predator visibility. However, as the plains dry, the herds push onward toward greener pastures, even venturing into the nutrient-scarce yet rain-rich northern reaches..

DAY 3: Serengeti National Park

Central Serengeti, known as Seronera, is the heart of the park and rich in wildlife year-round. Its vast plains, dotted with acacia trees and water sources, attract large numbers of predators like lions, leopards, and cheetahs. Resident animals such as elephants, giraffes, hippos, and antelopes are commonly seen, and it offers excellent game viewing even outside migration season. This area is ideal for classic safari experiences.

Accommodation: Land of Nature Camp

DAY 4: Ngorongoro Crater

Ngorongoro Crater is a breathtaking natural wonder and one of Africa's best wildlife destinations. Formed by a collapsed volcano, it's the world's largest intact caldera. The crater floor is home to a dense population of animals including lions, elephants, rhinos, buffalos, zebras, and flamingos. Its lush landscapes and year-round water make it ideal for game viewing. A visit here offers an unforgettable glimpse into a thriving, self-contained ecosystem.

Accommodation: Farm of Dreams Lodge

DAY 5: Tarangire National Park

Tarangire National Park is known for its giant baobab trees, large herds of elephants, and diverse wildlife along the Tarangire River. Enjoy a final game drive through this scenic park, spotting lions, giraffes, and more. After the game drive, you'll transfer by road to Arusha Airport to catch your flight to Zanzibar. This marks the end of your unforgettable safari adventure.
